## *Event Logistics and Details*

**Accommodations** – You will stay in a heated cabin on bunk beds. 4 guests per cabin, and there are 8 bunks to provide for luggage, etc. The cabins are wired for plug ins. Linens are provided, but please feel free to bring your favorite pillows, blankets, and whatever amenities that will make your stay even more comfortable.

**Parking** – All cars must be parked in a secured lot onsite; no cars allowed at Camp Westwind facilities. All guests will be shuttled to and from lot for event.

**Pre-weekend Zoom** – ALL Weekend guests need to attend a pre-weekend Zoom meet-and-greet in February to review logistics and details. OTF wants to ensure everyone understands the unique nature of Camp Westwind and its stewardship of the UNESCO Biosphere region it is part of.

**Arrive** – Friday, March 1 early afternoon for 2:00 pm shuttle to Camp Westwind. Participants will be shuttled from the lot to the event location.

**Depart** – Sunday, March 3 at 1:00 pm from Camp Westwind. Participants will be shuttled from the event to the parking lot.

**Accessibility** – Please note that this full weekend is not ADA accessible. Camp Westwind is actively working to make it accessible by the summer of 2024, but renovations will not be completed until then.

Saturday's Dinner is ADA accessible, as are all other Oregon Truffle Festival events.
